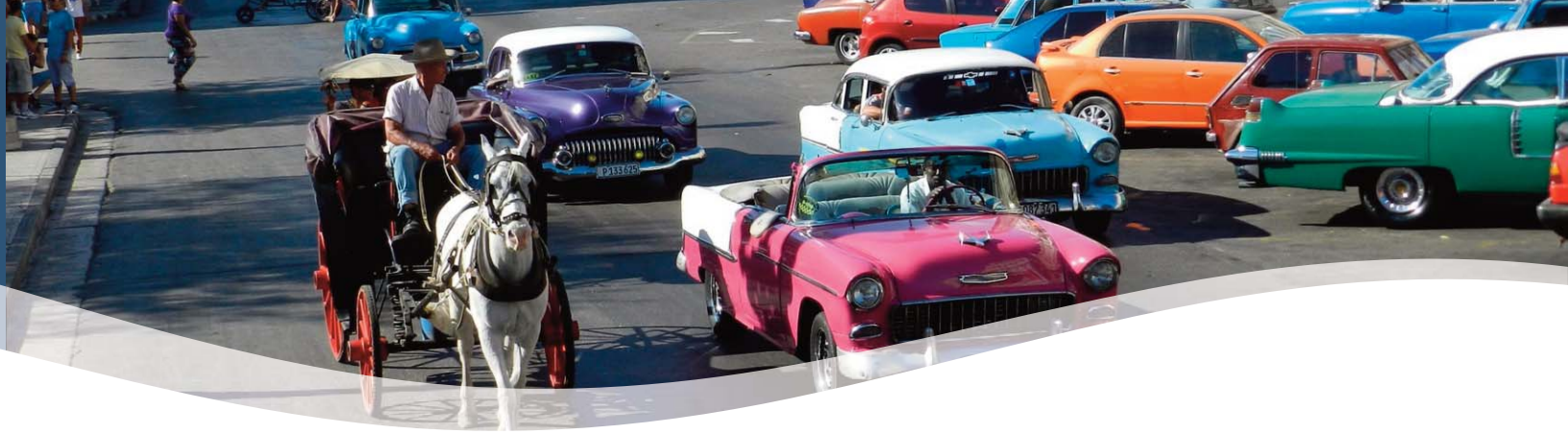

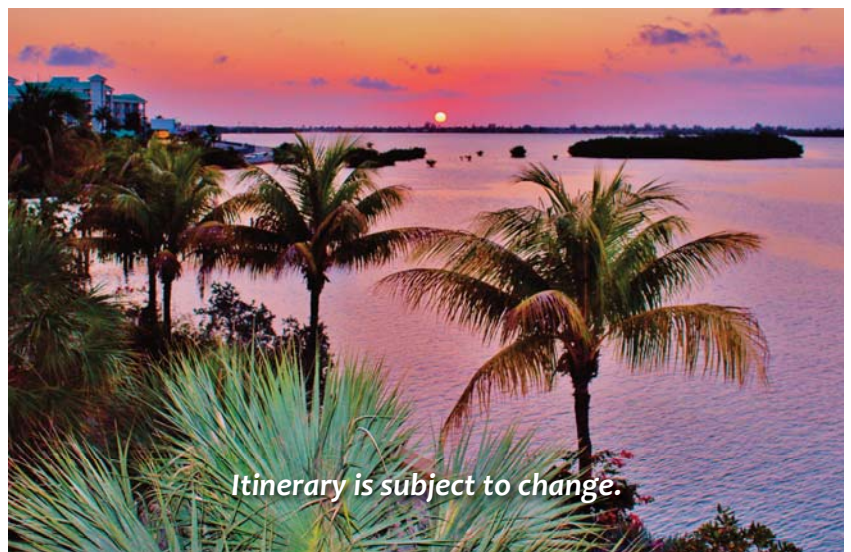

**CANCELLATION FEES:**

The optional Travel Protection Program covers 100% of Cancellation Fees, provided premium has been paid and reason for cancellation is coverable. Those who do not take travel protection should be aware of the of the following cancellation penalties: From day of registration to 181 days prior to departure, you will be charged a \$100 penalty plus any airline fees. Additionally, thereafter, you will be charged a single room supplement if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single plus the following charges also apply: 180-151 days prior to departure = \$200; 150-121 days prior to departure = \$300; 120-91 days prior to departure to day of departure = 50% of penalty; 90-61 days prior to departure to day of departure = 75% of penalty; 60-0 days prior to departure to day of departure = 100% of penalty. Cancellation must be submitted in writing. On or after day of departure, no refund for any services not used.

**FIT TO TRAVEL STATEMENT:**

Passengers registering for the tour accept the responsibility for being in good health and able to walk and travel on the cruise. The cruise ships can be quite large and require lots of walking onboard.
